- 2. Students are required to follow the following format while preparing the report:
  - All text should be in New Times Roman font, 12pt in height with 1.5 spacing, and justified.
  - Heading should be 14 units height, Times New Roman, Centered, Bold.
  - Subheading should be 12 units height, Times New Roman, Left aligned, Bold.
  - Margins: Each typed sheet will bear the margin mentioned here. For oddnumbered pages Left 1.5", top 1.5", right 1" and bottom 1", and for evennumbered pages Left 1.0", top 1.5", right 1.5" and bottom 1.0".
  - Numberings: The chapters will be designated by Arabic numerals, such as chapter 1, chapter 2, etc. The sections of a chapter will be numbered using decimal-type notations, for example, 3.2 refers to the second section of

chapter 3. Sub-sections will be numbered using two digits after the decimal, or alternatively as 3.2.4. Decimal-type notations will be used for numbering the figures/photos, charts, tables, and drawings within a chapter. Equations may also be preferably numbered in decimal-type notation within the brackets. For instance, Figure 3.2 refers to the second figure in Chapter 3, and similarly, Table 4.2, chart 3.3, etc. Appendixes will be numbered with capital Roman numerals, like Appendix I, Appendix II, etc. The pages containing the Title sheet, Declaration, Certificate, and Acknowledgements will not be numbered. One set of small Roman numerals (i, ii, iii...) will be used for numbering the pages of contents and nomenclature, which will be typed at the bottom centre of the page.

Any references are to be added within the references.bib file using  $BIBT_EX$  format. Citations within the document will appear as so: Doe et al. (2023).
